### Culinary

4 week package or single class - (2 credits possible)

These classes are created around the principles of cooking for a family and include all members of a family to participate, parents, students, and siblings. The emphasis is on basic cooking skills that promote healthy eating within the constraints of a busy family schedule.

## Auto Body

The focus of this course is to learn the basics of Auto Body techniques and skills to provide a seamless repair on a panel provided to the student. The panel provided to the student will be theirs to create damage to and then to repair. No outside work will be accepted during the course. NO Exceptions.

Once the panels are completed a light coat of etch primer will be applied to provide corrosion protection and prevent rust from damaging the panel. The panels can be considered for the next course, "Prep, Painting and Polishing" to be offered at a later date.

This is a 6 week course; classes begin March 3, 2016

Cost: 6 weeks, \$430.00

Course dates: March 3, 10, 17, 31, April 7, 21

Students must supply their own safety glasses and coveralls or shop coat. They can be provided for an extra cost. No open shoes, sandals or shorts allowed.

## Energy and Environmental Innovation

Students will learn how to become innovative change-makers in both their community and their future industries. Students will be exposed to a range of issues, skills and technologies with regards to climate change, petroleum exploration, sustainability and farm to table. The course is designed to be experiential for students. The course will take place in an interactive lab setting and on field trips where students will travel to industry experts,

This is a semester long course. There is no course fee; however there will be a field trip cost if the student participates.

## IT Essentials

IT Essentials introduces key concepts of data communications and the underlying theory of information technologies, including: telecommunications, basic computer diagnostics, and repair. Students will gain hands-on experience with supporting Information Technologies, including: hardware assembly/disassembly, setup, software installation and diagnostics. Successful completion of this course will give you a solid foundation to pursue other information technology support training.

This is a semester long course, there is no course fee.
