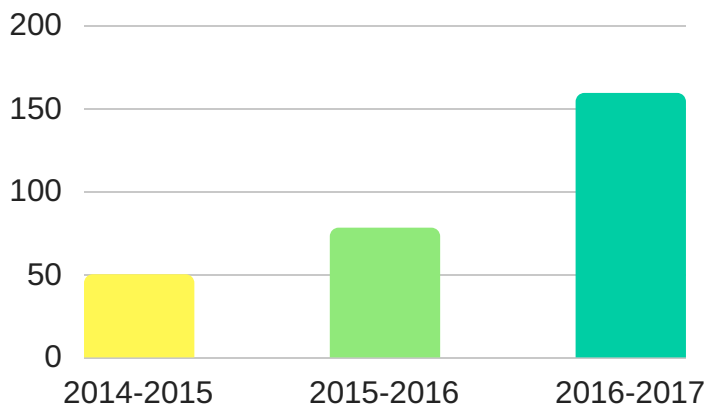


HOMework CLUB
